

Ministry of Health's Ordinance dated July 29th, 2021

Extract & courtesy translation

Art.3

1. The list of States and territories included in the list C of Annex 20 (DPCM 2MAR21) is superseded by the following:

List C

Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Croatia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Czech Republic, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Hungary, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Switzerland, Andorra, Principality of Monaco, Israel.

- 2. The entry into the national territory for the persons who in the preceding 14 days have stayed or transited in the Countries listed above is allowed on the following conditions:
- a) Submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever oversees the controls of the digital Passenger Locator Form (dPLF) on a mobile device or with a paper print-out.
- b) Submission to the carrier or to whoever is in charge of the controls of one of the COVID-19 green certificates as per art. 9 , paragraph 2 letters a), b) and c) of the Law Decree 22APR21 n. 52 or of an equivalent certification.
- c) In case of non-abidance by the prescriptions as per a) and b) above, performance of a five-days fiduciary isolation period at the address indicated in the dPLF and of a molecular or antigenic test at the end of such period.
- 3. Entry by the persons who in the preceding 14 days have stayed or transited in **Israel** is allowed on the following conditions:
- a) Submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever oversees the controls of the digital Passenger Locator Form (dPLF) on a mobile device or with a paper print-out.
- b) Submission to the carrier or to whoever oversees the controls of one of the COVID-19 green certifications or of a certification issued by the local health authorities following a vaccination validated by the EMA, accomplished healing or a negative molecular and antigenic test carried out in the 48 hours preceding the arrival.

Art. 4

1. The list of States and territories included in the **list D** of Annex 20 (DPCM 2MAR21) is superseded by the following:

List D

Albania, Saudi Arabia, Armenia, Australia, Azerbaijan, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Brunei, Canada, UAE, Japan, Jordan, Lebanon, Kosovo, Moldova, Montenegro, New Zealand, Qatar, United Kingdom, Republic of Korea, North Macedonia, Serbia, Singapore, USA, Ukraine, Taiwan, Hong Kong & Macao.

2. The entry into the national territory for the persons who in the preceding 14 days have stayed or transited in the Countries listed above is allowed on the following conditions:



- a) Submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever oversees the controls of the digital Passenger Locator Form (dPLF) on a mobile device or with a paper print-out.
- Submission to the carrier or to whoever oversees the controls of a certification attesting a negative molecular and antigenic test carried out in the 72 hours preceding the arrival (48 hours for the arrivals from the UK)
- c) Fiduciary isolation for 5 days at the address indicated in the dPLF and a molecular or antigenic test at the and of such period.
- 3.Entry by the persons who in the preceding 14 days have stayed or transited in **Canada**, **Japan** and **USA** is allowed on the following conditions:
- a) Submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever oversees the controls of the digital Passenger Locator Form (dPLF) on a mobile device or with a paper print-out.
- b) Submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever oversees the controls, either in digital or paper format, of a COVID-19 green certification or of a certification issued by the local health authorities following a vaccination validated by the EMA, accomplished healing or a negative molecular or antigenic test carried out in the 48 hours preceding the arrival.

Art. 5

- 1.The journeys <u>towards</u> the Countries included in the **list E** of Annex 20 (DPCM 2MAR21) are only permitted for one of the following reasons or conditions:
- a) Work reasons
- b) Absolute urgency
- c) Health reasons
- d) Study reasons
- e) Return to one's home, residence or dwellings (also a close partner's residence in a proven relationship is acceptable)
- 2. The entry into the national territory by the persons who in the 14 days preceding the arrival have stayed or transited in one of the Countries included in list E above is allowed on condition of abidance by the measures indicated in paragraph 3 below and exclusively for one of the following reasons or conditions:
- a) Work reasons
- b) Absolute urgency
- c) Health reasons
- d) Study reasons
- e) Return to one's home, residence or dwellings (also a close partner's residence in a proven relationship is acceptable)
- f) EU, Schengen Agreement, Andorra, Principality of Monaco, San Marino and Vatican State citizenship
- g) Relatives of the persons having citizenship in one of the Countries listed under f) above
- h) Long-term residents or citizen of third Countries entitled to resident status
- i) Relatives of the persons listed under h) above
- l) Entry into the national territory to reach the home, residence or dwellings of a person listed under f) and h) above, even if not a cohabitant, with whom there is a proven and stable relationship.
- m) Athletes, coaches, referees, sport journalists and assistants for sport events of national interest
- 3. The entries into the national territory as per paragraph 2 above shall abide by the following modalities:
- a) Submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever oversees the controls of the digital Passenger Locator Form (dPLF) on a mobile device or with a paper print-out.



- b) Submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever oversees the controls of a certification attesting a negative molecular and antigenic test carried out in the 72 hours preceding the arrival
- c) Fiduciary isolation for 10 days at the address indicated in the dPLF and a molecular or antigenic test at the end of such period.

Art. 7

The certifications released by the health authorities of Canada, Japan, Israel, United Kingdom and USA, either in digital or paper format, are accepted.

Art. 8

Children of less than 6 years of age are exempted from the performance of a molecular or antigenic test

Art. 9

The measures concerning the arrivals from India, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka and Brazil are hereby extended until 30AUG21
