

Ministry of Health Ordinance 14DEC2021 Extract & courtesy translation

•••

Art 1

Without prejudice to the any different prescription included in this ordinance, the measures mandated by the Ordinance of the Minister of Health on October 22nd, 2021 concerning movements to/from foreign States and territories are extended until the end of the emergency status and in any case **not beyond January 31**st **2022.**

Art. 2

- 1.Art 3.2 of the above-mentioned ordinance of the Minister of Health 22OCT2021 is substituted as follows:
- "2. Entry into the national territory for the persons who have stayed or transited, in the preceding 14 days, in one of the States or territories included in the **List C** of Annex 20 to DPCM of 2MAR21 is allowed at the following conditions:
- a) submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever may be in charge of the controls of the digital PLF either visually on one's own device or in hard copy.
- b) submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever may be in charge of the controls of one of the COVID-19 green certifications as per Art. 9 para 2 letters a) b) and c-bis) or equivalent of the law decree 22APR2021 n. 52 or equivalent.
- c) submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever may be in charge of the controls of the certification of having undergone, in the 48 hours preceding the entry into the national territory, a molecular test with negative result or, in the 24 hours preceding the entry into the national territory, an antigenic test with negative result.
- 2. After Art. 3.2 of the above-mentioned ordinance of the Minister of Health 22OCT2021 the following paragraph is inserted:
- "3. In case of failure to present one of the certifications listed in paragraph 2.b), without prejudice to the obligation to undergo a molecular or antigenic test as prescribed by paragraph 2.c), the 5 days fiduciary self-isolation at the address indicated in the PLF shall apply, along with the obligation to undergo a molecular or antigenic test at the end of such period".

Art. 3

1. The inventory of States included in the $\underline{\textbf{List D}}$ of Annex 20 to the DPCM 2MAR2021 is superseded by the following:

"List D

Argentina, Australia, Baharain, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Japan, Indonesia, Israel. Kuwait, New Zealand, Peru, Qatar, Rwanda, Saudi Arabia, United Kingdom & Northern Ireland, Republic of Korea, USA, UAE, Uruguay, Taiwan, Hong Kong & Macao".



2. Art 4.2.c of the Minister of Health's ordinance 22OCT2021 is substituted as follows:

"c) submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever is in charge of the controls of the certification of having undergone, in the **72 hours** preceding the entry into the national territory, a **molecular test** with negative result or an **antigenic test** with negative result in the **24 hours** preceding the entry into the national territory.

The deadline for the **molecular test** is reduced to **48 hours** for the arrivals from **UK & Northern Ireland** (including Gibraltar, Isle of Man, Channel Islands and British bases in Cyprus and excluding the territories outside the European continent."

Art.4

With regard to the arrivals from the States and territories included in the <u>List E</u> of Annex 20 to the DPCM 2MAR2021, as mandated by Art. 5 of the Minister of Health's ordinance 22OCT2021, paragraph 3b) of the above-mentioned Art. 5 is substituted as follows:

"b) submission upon boarding to the carrier or to whoever is in charge of the controls of the certification of having undergone, in the **72 hours** preceding the entry into the national territory, a **molecular test** with negative result or an **antigenic test** with negative result in the **24 hours** preceding the entry into the national territory.

Art. 6

The measures introduced by the Minister of Health's ordinance 26NOV2021, concerning the arrivals' regime from **South Africa**, **Lesotho**, **Botswana**, **Zimbabwe**, **Malawi**, **Mozambique**, **Namibia**, **Eswatini** are **extended until** the end of the emergency status and in any case not beyond **31JAN2022**

Art. 7

This ordinance is **effective** as from **16DEC2021** and until the end of the emergency status and in any case not beyond **31JAN2022**
